This list includes the minimum items that should be in a patrol box for preparing patrol meals. It will also include a set of condiments, but you need to be careful they don't stay there too long! This list assumes that each patrol member brings their own personal gear.

  - \_\_\_\_\_ **Charcoal** - For Dutch Ovens \*
  - \_\_\_\_\_ **Duct Tape** - For equipment repair. \*
  - \_\_\_\_\_ **Garbage Bags (Roll or box)**
  - \_\_\_\_\_ **Matches** - Kitchen matches, store in ziplock bag.
  - \_\_\_\_\_ **Notebook & Pen/Pencil** - Used for writing down instructions, ad-hoc lists, etc. \*
  - \_\_\_\_\_ **Paper Plates, Bowls, Cups** - For those meals that need to be cleaned up fast. \*
  - \_\_\_\_\_ **Paper Towel**
  - \_\_\_\_\_ **Plastic Utensils** - In case someone forgets their own. \*
  - \_\_\_\_\_ **Toilet Paper** - Store in large zip lock bag, or waterproof container.
  - \_\_\_\_\_ **Zip Lock™ Bags** \*

## Cleaning Gear

- \_\_\_\_\_ **Bleach** - (Screw-On Top)
  - \_\_\_\_\_ **Dish Washing Soap** - (Liquid, with a screw on top)
  - \_\_\_\_\_ **Plastic Wash Basins** - 3 required (Wash, Rinse, Bleach Rinse)
  - \_\_\_\_\_ **Scouring Pads**
  - \_\_\_\_\_ **Sponge**

## Camping Gear
